Save money with the Low Emission Zone Support Fund Do you live within 20 kilometres of Glasgow, Edinburgh, Aberdeen or Dundee city centre?

Then you could be eligible for a grant of up to £3000. Through the Low Emission Zone Support Fund your household may be able to receive:

- A £2000 cash grant for disposing of your older car.
- Plus up to two £500 'Travel Better' vouchers to help buy a new bike, e-bike, rail or bus pass.

Low Emission Zones (LEZs) to improve air quality are to be introduced across Aberdeen, Dundee, Edinburgh and Glasgow between February 2022 and May 2022.

LEZs are key to improving air quality, protecting public health and supporting Scotland's wider climate change ambitions.

Access will be restricted for the most polluting vehicles. Vehicles that don't meet the emission standards will not be able to enter the zone. If they do, the owner of the vehicle will have to pay a fine.



The proposed LEZ engine classification minimums are:

- Euro 6 for diesel cars and vans (typically registered from September 2015)
- Euro 4 for petrol vehicles (typically registered from January 2006)
