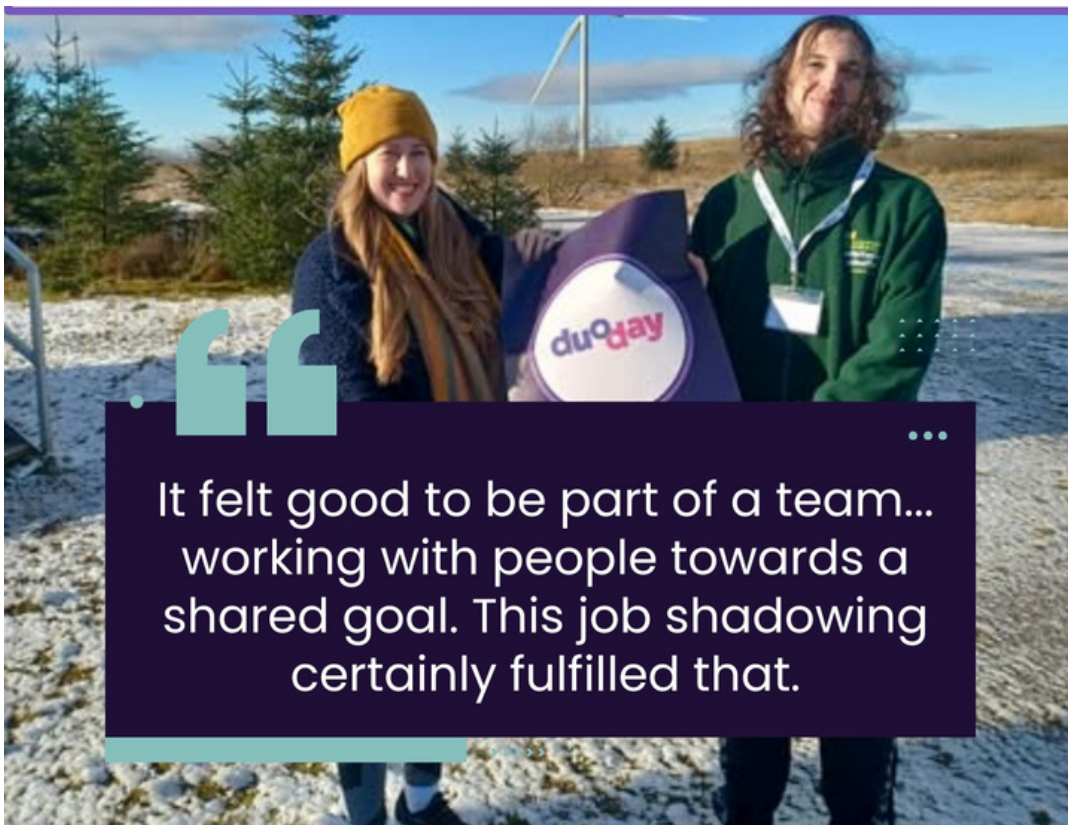
Get Involved
